

# SAINTS TABERNACLE DAY SCHOOL

## Cost/Fees

Saints Tabernacle Day School is a Private School that is tuition based. The tuition can be paid in full (annually), it can be paid semi-annually (twice a school year), monthly (10 payments), or on a weekly basis-due on the Monday of service. There is a one (1) time registration fee of **\$150.00 which includes the gym uniform for the first (1st) school year of attendance.** (Students graduating from Saints Tabernacle Pre-K receive a registration discount fee of \$50.00). **All returning students pay an annual registration fee of \$50.00 to be paid by August 30th.**

### Discounts and Payment Options:

- Tuition payments for September of each school year are due by August 20th.
- A 10% discount is given if tuition for the school year is paid in full at the beginning of the year.
- Sibling discounts are available for all tuition payment plan options listed below.

### **If Tuition is Paid in Full by August 20th**

**Weekly Payment Plan:**

Tuition paid weekly is due on the Monday of service. Tuition paid after Tuesday each week incurs a \$30.00 late fee. **No child will be admitted to school if tuition is not paid for two weeks. To be reinstated, tuition for the two (2) weeks owed, plus \$60.00 in late fees and the current week's tuition must be paid in full.**

Saints Tabernacle Day School reserves the right to retain all academic records for accounts that are past due. If a student's tuition is unpaid, transfer documents will not be released and the student will not be eligible for graduation.

**Before and After Care Fees:**

Before and After Care fees are assessed at a weekly rate of \$45 for each service. **There is a discounted rate of \$70 per week if a student is enrolled in both Before and After Care.**

**Summer Camp Fees:**

The summer camp weekly fee is \$130.00 per week and does not include the mandatory \$50 registration fee and summer trip fees. Parents receive a 10% discount for summer camp fees paid in full. We offer a 10% sibling discount for summer camp.

### **Gym Uniforms:**

Gym uniforms are included with your child's registration fee. Saints Tabernacle Day School provides a Gym T-shirt and sweatshirt as a part of the initial registration fee. Additional Gym T-shirts and sweatshirts can be purchased for a total of \$30.00.

### **Trip Fees**

Students at Saints Tabernacle Day School participate in curriculum supported field trips. Trip fees are invoiced in Procare and payment is due by the due date given. **Please note, in order for a child to attend a field trip, tuition must be current. If there is a tuition balance at the time of the trip, your child will not be allowed to attend and any payment made for the trip will be credited towards your child's tuition balance owed.**

### **Subsidy Eligibility**

Should your child qualify for subsidy but lose eligibility at any time during the year, it is the parent's responsibility to immediately contact the ELRC case worker to resolve the issue. During the time of ineligibility, the parent is responsible for all related fees. Saints Tabernacle Day School is unable to provide service free of charge during the redetermination process.
